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## Image area (screen material)

### **dnp Supernova 08-85**

Dusty: Dust with a feather duster, a dry lint-free soft cloth or something similar. Light vacuum cleaning is possible but be careful not to apply too much pressure on non-rigid screens (i.e. Supernova Core, Supernova XL) and make sure to use a fitting with bristles that are neither too soft nor scratch the surface.

Dirty: Wash with a solution of neutral/mild soap or detergent and lukewarm water. Use a clean lint-free soft cloth applying only light pressure. Never rub the screen hard and persistently to remove stains, as this could cause permanent damage to the screen surface. On non-rigid screens (i.e. Supernova Flex Classic, Supernova Core), apply gentle counter-pressure on the reverse side. Ordinary window cleaner, monitor cleaner, spectacles cleaner or similar can also be used. Greasy fingermarks can be removed with a small amount of ethanol or isopropanol. Never use acetone or something organic solvent based. Never use detergents that are alkaline or acidic. Wipe off with a dry lint-free soft cloth and make sure the screen is completely dry afterwards.

Markers: Should somebody accidentally write on the screen with a permanent marker it can easily be

removed. Overwrite with a dry marker and use a paint pad or suitable eraser. We can recommend using the Legamaster MagicWipe. If this is not enough, a small amount of ethanol or isopropanol can be used. Always use a dry cloth to erase dry-marker messages from the screen. Wipe off with a dry lint-free soft cloth and make sure the screen is completely dry afterwards. Never rub the screen hard and persistently to remove stains, as this could cause permanent damage to the screen surface.




### **dnp Supernova STL**

Caution! You should be very careful when touching the screen material as it is relatively easy to leave permanent fingermarks or scratch the surface. We recommend always to use cotton gloves when touching the screen surface.

Dusty: Dust carefully with a feather duster, a dry lint-free soft cloth or something similar. Always wipe carefully along the linear lens structure (sideways on landscape screens). Do not wipe across lenses and do not apply much pressure on the surface as this could damage the screen material and make a noticeable mark. Light vacuum cleaning is possible but be careful not to apply too much pressure on the screen and make sure to use a fitting with bristles that are neither too soft nor scratch the surface.

Dirty: Start with a damp cloth and wipe carefully sideways following the direction of the lens structure. Do not wipe across lenses and do not apply much pressure on the surface as this could damage the screen material and make a noticeable mark. If this is not enough, wash with a solution of neutral/mild soap or detergent and lukewarm water. Use a clean lint-free

soft cloth. Never rub the screen hard and persistently to remove stains, as this could cause permanent damage to the screen surface. On non-rigid screens (i.e. Supernova STW), apply gentle counter-pressure on the reverse side. Never use alcohol, acetone or something organic solvent based. Never use detergents that are alkaline or acidic. Wipe off with a dry lint-free soft cloth and make sure the screen is completely dry afterwards.



## Décor frame

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### Décor frame

#### **Anodized aluminum**

Dusty: Dust with a feather duster, a dry lint-free cloth or something similar. Light vacuum cleaning is possible, but make sure to use a fitting with bristles that are neither too soft nor scratch the surface.

Dirty: Wash with a solution of neutral/mild soap or detergent and lukewarm water. Use a clean lint-free cloth or soft brush. If this is not enough, a mild acidic solution or suitable polish can be used. Avoid alkaline solutions. Chemicals may stain the surface so wipe off immediately after use with a dry lint-free soft cloth and make sure the frame is completely dry afterwards. Be careful not to scratch the surface. Never rub hard and persistently to remove stains, as this could permanently damage the surface.

#### **Powder coating**

Caution! Ultra-matte powder coated surfaces are sensitive to rubbing. The mechanical force applied when rubbing could remove particles from the surface and make it glossier in some areas and uneven in overall appearance.

Dusty: Dust carefully with a feather duster, a dry lint-free soft cloth or something similar. Light vacuum cleaning is possible, but make sure to use a fitting with bristles that are neither too soft nor scratch the surface.


Dirty: Dab or gently wash with a solution of neutral/mild soap or detergent and lukewarm water. Use a clean lint-free cloth. If this is not enough, a small amount of ethanol or isopropanol can be used. Chemicals may stain the surface so dab gently wipe off immediately after use with a dry lint-free soft cloth and make sure the frame is completely dry afterwards. Be careful not to scratch the surface. Never rub hard and persistently to remove stains, as this could permanently damage the surface.

#### **Painted**

Same as for anodized aluminum.

#### **Black Velvet**

Same as for Black Velvet masking frame.

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### Masking frame

#### **Black Velvet**

Dusty: Dust with a feather duster, a dry lint-free cloth or something similar. Sticky particles may require a clothes brush, toothbrush or fluff roller. Light vacuum cleaning is possible, but make sure to use a fitting with bristles that are neither too soft nor scratch the surface.

Dirty: Clean with a solution of neutral/mild soap or detergent and lukewarm water. Apply with a small brush. We recommend using a soft toothbrush. Be careful not to apply too much pressure on the surface as this may scratch the surface and leave noticeable marks. Never use alcohol, acetone or something organic solvent based. Never use detergents that are alkaline or acidic. Harsh detergents may stain the surface. Dry with a lint-free cloth or with a hairdryer on low heat setting. Never rub the black velvet material hard and persistently to remove stains, as this could permanently damage the surface.
